GRADUATE DEGREE OVERVIEW

The 36-semester hour graduate program in Project Management provides each student with a focused, applied and rigorous experience in creating, developing, implementing and assessing projects and the resulting products using *traditional* and *agile* methods. To produce a high-quality product or service on time and to that meets or exceeds client's expectations, the skills and knowledge of a typical subject matter expert are not enough. The complexities of modern product development and project management require a professional with specific technical knowledge with strong project management and leadership skills. This program of study leads to a Master of Science degree that prepares the student for career advancement in the field of project management and for positions such as project manager, project coordinator, lead project engineer, Agile project manager or ScrumMaster.

PMGT graduates are able to:

- Demonstrate the applied knowledge and technical expertise in the management of projects to meet desired needs within constraints and aligned with *traditional* and *agile* professional standards and guides
- Demonstrate professional behavior by showing how successful project management will use stakeholder engagement, communication, leadership, and teamwork that is ethical, and culturally aware
- Demonstrate strategic financial and organizational contextual awareness and insight by linking key stakeholder objectives to sustainable competitive strategies required to deliver value across operational functions.

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT

This Certificate Program is designed for students with a desire to understand both *traditional* and *agile* principles and practices of project management with the goal of obtaining **an academic Certificate in Project Management from Harrisburg University** and **an industry certification from the Project Management Institute (PMI)[®]**, either the Project Management Professional – PMP[®], or Certified Associate Project Manager – CAPM[®].

The Certificate in Project Management requires all the core Graduate Level Project Management courses (six 3 credit hour courses – non-capstone) required to obtain a Master of Science in Project Management. These core courses when completed successfully apply directly towards a Master of Science in Project Management if at some point the student decides to seek a full Master of Science graduate degree.

To complete the Certificate in Project Management at Harrisburg University, a graduate must also complete the necessary requirements for the PMP[®] or CAPM[®] including passing the relevant exam from PMI[®].

The Agile Lean Graduate Certificate is designed for students with a desire to understand the principles and practices of Agile Lean project management methods. The Grad Certificate provides students with a thorough understanding and application of Agile Lean frameworks used in project management and product development. The certificate builds upon an Agile Project Management with Scrum course to prepare students for experiential courses in applying Scrum to real-world projects, conducting new product development with Agile, and leading Agile Lean transformations in organizations.

To complete the Agile Lean Certificate at Harrisburg University, a graduate must also complete the necessary requirements for the PSM I™ or PSPO™ including passing the relevant exam from Scrum.org.
